4. SCOA Report

- SCOA Report Sept 22 from Jon Wheatcroft (Chair)
- In the next six month we (ie you too!) are responsible for putting on no fewer than four major events:-
- In March 2023 (25th & 26th) we are hosting the British Long Distance Championships & British Relay Championships. Paul Fox (SN) is co-ordinating, BKO are leading on the individual and TVOC on the relays. This is a big undertaking for us, one of the smaller regions, so we are expecting that everybody in the Region will want to volunteer their help on at least one day. Please put the dates in your diary now.
- Looming rather larger on the horizon is our hosting of the Senior Home Internationals. These take place on the weekend of 5th & 6th November. SOC seem to have the individual races which take place before the November Classic on the Sunday well under control. The relays are being held near Bordon in Hampshire on the Saturday (5th) and could do with a few more hands. So, if you fancy seeing Great Britain and Ireland's very best in action at close quarters or just feel like helping do, please, get in touch with me.
- Unfortunately, the first event scheduled for the 2022 2023 SCOA league has had to be postponed, so SCOL 1 will now be the BADO event at Micheldever on 23rd October which will also host the SCOL 2021 2022 prizegiving. Details of other SCOA league events are on the SCOA website. Our meeting also made a small change to the rules of this competition to award a mapper who would be non-competitive 100 points, as is already the case with other officials. More awards are up for grabs at the November Classic on 6th November which also hosts this year's SCOA Championships.
- One of the more pleasant tasks of the committee is to read the reports from our talented young
 athletes who have been on international duty and attended summer camps at home and abroad
 and to also offer them financial support towards their, often considerable, expenses.

- John also added that At the Junior Inter-Regional Championships (on 24/25 September) the South Central Junior Squad achieved its best result since 1999, coming 5th in the individual races and 6th in the relays (out of the 12 regional squads). An excellent result, especially since they were two scorers down from a possible of 12 runners counting towards the team score. Both days were in the sand dunes at Tyrella, Northern Ireland, which is on a headland with a fantastic view across the loch to the Mountains of Mourne. The courses were highly technical and there were no easy options or long routes round paths on any legs. The vegetation was also tough in places with sections where the gorse and brambles had extended further than on the map. Two juniors from BKO were part of the SCOA junior squad: Adam Methven was 3rd on M18 and also his team was 3rd in the Men's relays. Amelia Wing was 6th on W16 and together with Josie Hilton from SN who was 4th, they had a combined score making them second on W16 (beating Scotland into 3rd place).
- The following weekend Adam was representing GB at the Junior European Championships in the Harz Mountains of Germany, an area with distinctive sandstone outcrops, complete with castles, pointing out of the forest. There was a sprint, long and relay competition. Adam's best day was on the long where he was 31st out of the 60 competitors on M18, the top three coming from Sweden, Switzerland and Denmark.
