#### 2.1 Chair's Update.

#### 4. SCOA Report (Fiona)

Last meeting held on 7th September.

- Treasurer resigned mid-term and I have taken over as Interim Treasurer in the meantime so that grant payments to juniors can be made. All clubs need to actively seek a replacement.
- There was a reminder from the Technical Officer (Katy Stubbs) that there has been a rule change since the beginning of 2023 that Level B events no longer need to have a Controller from a different region, but they must be from a different club and 'perceived to be able to act independently of event officials'. It does say that ideally the Controller would be from a different region.
- SN have applied for a grant from SCOA of £3,435 to buy 50 SIAC dibbers from the JK surplus. It will be put before the SCOA committee at the December meeting and Jon Wheatcroft current SCOA Chair suggests that other clubs are informed of the bid and invited to do likewise. As the Interim Treasurer I can say that SCOA has lots of money. I will check the wording of the constitution to confirm what SCOA can make grants for.

#### Post meeting note

SCOA Constitution states:

- The Executive Committee shall have the power:
  - d) to purchase equipment or services consistent with the development of orienteering.
- g) to carry out any other task or use the Association's funds in order to achieve the Purpose of the Association.

#### 5.3 Results

- Steve reminded everyone that the course names in racesignup MUST match the planners course names
- Black Park Results. Brian has arranged to have available an extra 100 SIAC cards from TVOC
  and has passed the numbers along with instructions to Steve in order to add them to the hire card
  list. Steve to run the results.
- Star Posts Night event Steve to run the results and we agreed not to hire in any extra SIAC's
- Results for the 2024 Concorde Chase Peter Foster (BOK) will be the SI guru and for SITiming equipment hire and his services costs are about £750. Hire of TVOC controls and SIAC's has been arranged with control cost about £300. Total £1,050 Committee confirmed that Brian can book.
- Brian has produced a guide 'BKO use of SI and SIAC' to help Planners, Organisers and volunteers Rev B. This was discussed and based on our insurance conditions and practicality it was agreed control stakes can go out up to 48hrs and controls up to 24hrs before an event if away from public access.

- Brian has also produced a 'Start Notice Competitor Instructions' plus an 'SI Start Layout' as a
  set of instructions for competitors, start team and use for results teams for the new SI system.
  Brian to arrange laminating. To be used at all Starts. Discussed and no changes needed although
  Simon is concerned about position of SIAC TEST. Brian to investigate.
